


Chemicals that should be avoided include the following:

Aprotic Solvent (e.g., Dimethyl Formamide, Dimethyl Acetamide, N-Methyl Pyrolidine, etc.) Chlorinated Solvents (e.g., Methylene Chloride, Chloroform, Carbon Tetrachloride, etc.) Ketones (e.g., Acetone, Diacetone Alcohol, etc.)

Silicones or Silicone based Defoamers (e.g., Siloxane)
